The Cedar Bluff Elementary & Middle Health Clinics provide minor first aid and care for the children in our school. This is a valuable service that greatly enhances the nurturing environment Cedar Bluff schools strive to maintain for our students. **Our clinics are staffed by volunteers and we need your help!** Would you be willing to assist us to get our clinic open?

In order to volunteer in our clinic, you must pass a Level 3 KCS background check **and** complete a course through East Tennessee Children's Hospital. This course is not difficult and is paid for by our PTSA. No prior medical knowledge or experience is required. Stay tuned for the next training date which will be held in the Schmid Conference room on the 2nd Floor of the Koppel Plaza Building directly across from the main hospital.

The PTSA request a minimum of one day or two half days per month of volunteer work, to ensure adequate staffing, and also due to the training fee which is paid by PTSA. Of course, you can volunteer as often as you'd like!

Ready to volunteer? This service is appreciated and depended upon by the children and staff of our school. By volunteering, you can help ensure that the clinic doors will be open when your child is the sick or injured one that needs assistance!
